- Liability Insurance Nancy has not had time to pursue this.
- Veterans Memorial landscaping Mary asked Lindy to contact the Garden Club for help with trimming and weeding. They will work out a day this fall to get together.
- Quilt Info –Lindy and Chris are working on an information sheet to go with quilt display. Lindy reported that the quilt rack has a coat of polyurethane and is ready for use. Quilts are in special archival boxes on top of shelves on the left side of the History Room.
- Visions Workshop Follow-up Nancy and Judy to meet again to finalize a presentation for the board. Nancy has done an organizational chart and a timeline. She just has to fine-tune it.
- New Logo Sue Finney brought drafts of the three possible logo styles that her daughter had designed for us. The board was not able to decide on any one of them, so the project has been held over in the hope that we can come up with a design that everyone agrees upon.
- Curiosity Shop Final Report Lindy gave a verbal report. Will submit one in writing for the annual meeting. We made almost \$2,000 with just three market days this year.
- Donald Hall DVDs are selling well. We have already made \$410 to date.
- Video Progress (Clara, Thelma, Esther) –Mary reported that Theresa has finished a draft of the first two and is working on Esther. We still need more photos to insert into the videos. Have not heard from Nancy Langley. Fred Ogmundson will get Mary the name and contact info for Thelma's daughter. He has some photos that he will have scanned to add to the video.
- Audio Harrison Hunt has agreed to be interviewed again in October or November in the history room.

- Education Tent at the Farmers Market This Sat, Sept 22, Catherine and Liz will be in the education tent. The tent needs fixing. Bill Doody bought the replacement parts that are in the tent bag. They just need to be put in place.
- Docents 9/22 and 9/29 Fred will be in the history room this Sat. 22 and Catherine will be the docent for the last day, Sept 29.
- Old Survey Records Julie brought in John Stearns' survey records (boxed) that her husband,
 John, donated to the WHS. The general consensus is that they need to be saved. However, storage
 space is a problem. One idea is that we could give them to the State Surveyors Association in
 Concord as they would be pleased to take them. Fred would also like to have them. Sue asked if it
 is possible to take out Wilmot records from the box? No decision was made. Records will stay in
 the History Room for now.

New Business

- WCA Wilmotpalooza WHS received an invitation to put up a tent on the green from 10:30 2:00 on September 30. Lindy read the list of events for the day. There was no interest on the part of the board members for putting up a tent on the green. Mary will send an email to Ann Davis to let her know.

 Wilmot's history and put them together on a reference shelf. She also purchased a book from the
 Warner Historical Society. Chapter 30 in the book gives the Kearsarge Gore history. The board
 voted to reimburse Liz for \$40 cost of the book, which will be placed with the other history
 books.
- Nancy reported that she was able to salvage more paper work from the Brady House. She and Catherine will go through it to see what is worth saving.
